

2015 GCSE Results

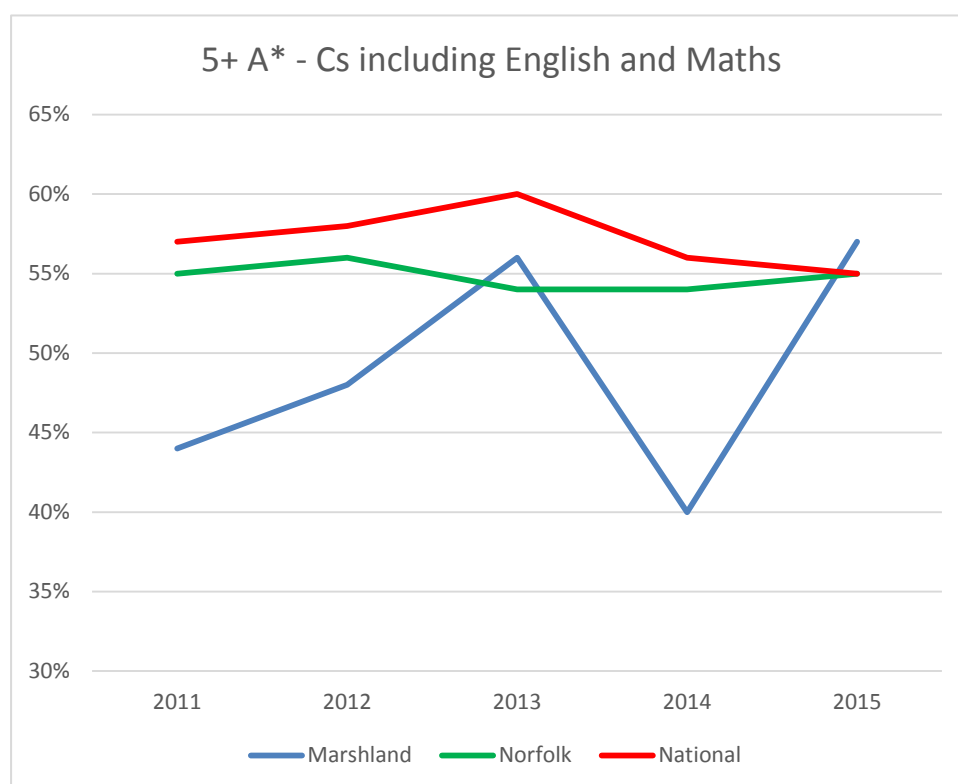

Levels of Progress in English and Maths

The “expected” amount of progress between Key Stage 2 and the end of Key Stage 4 is 3 levels (3LP). “More than expected progress” is 4 levels (4LP). These are important measures because they take into consideration the students’ starting points, not just their outcomes, so it is a good measure of the impact the school has had on the students. The National average in 2014 was 74% for 3LP in English and 67% for 3LP in maths.
