Year 7

During Year 7, students will investigate the following enquiries:

Autumn Term

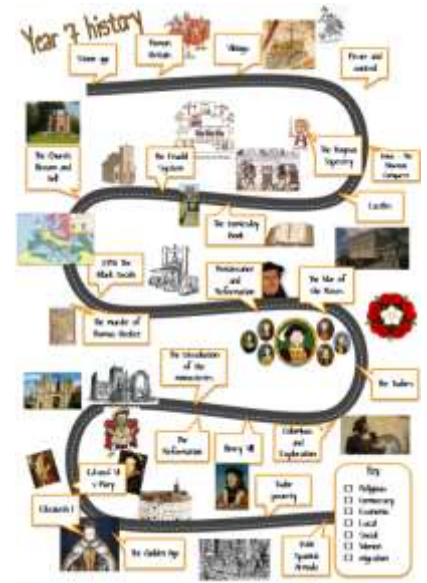
- Who are the British?
- Why was 1066 such a dramatic year?
- What was life like after the conquest?

Spring Term

- Could a medieval king do whatever he wanted?
- Was it all muck and misery in the Middle Ages?
- Why was the Royal family at war with itself?

Summer Term

- How did the world become a smaller place?
- Exploding myths about why the Reformation happened
- How far did the Reformation change England?



Year 8

During Year 8, students will investigate the following enquiries:

Autumn Term

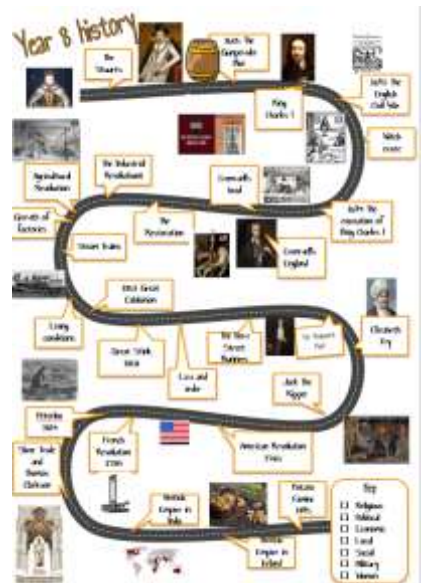
- How had the world been turned upside down by 1660?

Spring Term

- How did the Industrial Revolution move people?
- What was it like to live in Industrial towns?

Summer Term

- How did Britain build an Empire?
- How far did the American people take control of their own Destiny?
- How far did the French people take control of their own destiny?



Year 9

During Year 9 students will investigate the following enquiries:

Autumn Term

- What caused WW1?
- How was WW1 fought?
- Why was it so difficult to make peace?
- Was Hitler solely responsible for WW2?
- What were famous battle strategies used during ww2?

Spring Term

- What was the Holocaust and why did it happen?
- What kind of war was the Cold War?

Summer Term

- How much has British Society changed since 1900?
