




Each session is personalised to the requirements of each school/college, as well as being adaptable to the needs of individual pupils/students.


TAKE LEARNING OUTSIDE OF THE CLASSROOM

All participants leave The Playground with a huge sense of achievement. The mud will – eventually! - wash off, but the memories will last a lifetime!




