Character and Culture

KS3 Curriculum Overview

Year 7

Autumn Term

Students start their Unifrog journey learning how to explore future career prospects and possibilities. They explore the skills of leadership allowing them to understand their own strengths and weaknesses to allow them to take leadership in their own future projects.

Spring Term

They focus on the skill of organisation in both school life and linked to future careers. They look at organising their own competencies and experiences. This then lead to them creating their own short project on personal enterprise, leading to them exploring their own ideas of starting their own business therefore developing critical thinking.

Summer Term

Students focus upon resilience and their own initiative developing analytical skills, creative thinking, independence and resilience. This then develops into an exploration of self-mastery; managing their own stress and anxiety. These skills are developed to help build the resilience needed throughout their school life and beyond.

Year 8

Autumn Term

After a refresher course of using Unifrog to its full potential, students begin to look at the variety of choices available to them at Marshland High School. This overview of a wide range of subjects shows them how the lesson they learn in school translate to future career prospects such as working within the NHS or the Armed Forces.

Spring Term

Students during the spring term start on their path to becoming confident and competent public speakers, this is done through an oracy project where they will develop their listening and communication skills as well as understanding the implementation and impact of their voice.

Summer Term

Continuing on their process of becoming masters of spoken language students continue to look at various forms of communication, throughout this term they look at ideas such as body language, rhetoric and vocabulary choices. This leads to an accumulation of their knowledge and skills to allow them to deliver their own key presentation.
