<p>Admin Staff: Improvement in parental and student engagement.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lots of pastoral care was offered to our PP students, especially mental health and emotional wellbeing support. • Regular contact and home visits were completed throughout lockdown on vulnerable students and their families.
<p>Educational Support: Support with students' academic progress across both key stages of the curriculum.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic devices were distributed to all PP students which had no access to a device to support their home learning. • Revision guides and workbooks were purchased to support home learning across both key stage 3 and 4. In Technology, equipment packs were purchased for KS4 students meaning that students had access to all the subject specific stationary to continue with their home learning.

<p>Teaching Staff: Raise aspirations of students to support them reaching their full potential. To ensure that all students become well rounded citizens within society by instilling the schools core values.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All PP students in year 11 applied to at least two post 16 providers relevant to their ability. • Through the Trust we now have access to a level 6 trained independent careers advisor. Lots of her work has involved working with PP students to raise their aspirations. • Weekly assemblies and weekly awards continued to be handed out during lockdown. School core values are heavily embedded into the assembly programme and the structure of the rewards. PP students were well represented within the rewards.
