Dear Parents & Carers

Year 11 GCSE examination preparation and upcoming events

I want to take this opportunity to update you on upcoming events in preparing your child for their GCSE examinations and their remaining few months at Marshland.

With the latest set of PPEs exams now over and GCSE practical exams in full swing, I wanted to say how impressed I have been with our students' behaviour and attitude in completing the theory and practical exams. I hope their results reflect the effort they applied to their revision and PPEs.

I would remind you that if your child has an illness during the final exams in the summer, then a doctor's note is required to be sent to school for the exam board to make their final decision on any special consideration that may apply. Special consideration is only given in very serious or exceptional circumstances and often has a very limited positive impact on a child's GCSE outcome. If your child fails to attend an exam with no valid reason, then the school may charge you for the wasted entry fee.

The PPE papers are currently being marked with plans to share the results and your child's final report with you on Tuesday 26th March, ready for your child's last Parents Evening on **Wednesday 27th March**. Parent Evening meetings will be held in person at school between 4pm and 7pm. Our staff are working hard to ensure that your child is as prepared as possible for their final exams. This includes an extensive additional intervention programme taking place throughout the week, further details below. If your child has been invited to a session they must attend to ensure that they achieve their potential in the summer. If your child has not had a specific invitation they can:

- Speak to their teachers about revision outside of lesson
- Use the **GCSEPod** site that the school has purchased to support their learning.
- Complete past exam board papers and check their work themselves is highly recommended.
- Attend additional sessions in the Easter and May half term breaks details for Easter are below and May details will be shared closer to the time. I would strongly recommend that your child attends as many of these as possible.

I also must stress the importance of school attendance at this time. Every lesson and intervention session really count, and I am sure that I can rely on you to get your child into school, even if they are a little under the weather. Your child needs to be in everyday right up until their final timetabled exam. If this changes, we will update you accordingly.

During the exam period, we will be holding final revision sessions after school prior to each exam. This will be an opportunity to revise any last bits of information and to get your child fully prepared for their exam the following day with tips on how to answer questions as effectively as possible. Again, I will share further information nearer the time.

Between now and the final summer exam programme, there will be a number of final practical/speaking exams in Creative Design, Art, Photography, Physical Education, French, German and English. These exams all form part of your child's final grade and must be completed on the set dates. Failure to attend these practical/speaking exams will significantly impact your child's chance of achieving the grade that they are capable of, so please ensure that they are fully prepared and ready.

Your child has been given the exams timetable, highlighting what day and time each exam is. Please go through this with them. The Government has assigned Wednesday 26th June as a contingency date, for any significant event that has impacted the exams taking place, so your child must be available to be in school on this day if required.

Please check that your child has completed all applications for Sixth Form, College or an apprenticeship as soon as possible and they have informed the school. Interviews are currently being held and we will support your child through this process.

The Year 11 Prom is on Friday 28th June at Knights Hill, King's Lynn subject to sufficient numbers. Tickets cost £45 and can be purchased via Parent Pay. The ticket covers food, snacks, drinks, music and entertainment. If the required minimum number of tickets are not purchased, the venue may have to change to Marshland High School at a reduced cost. A final decision will be made by May half term when we have a final idea of numbers.

Carriages are due to arrive from 6pm, with students being invited to be seated for the evening to start at 7pm. We hope that you can come and join in the celebrations of your child's time at Marshland High. The Prom is by invite only. The school reserves the right to withdraw an invitation if the required attendance, standards and behaviour are not being met in school up to their final day.

Finally, in your child's final day assembly I would like to provide each student with a message from home from their loved ones. If you would like to provide a message, please get them to me by the start of the May half term break, with your child's full name on the envelope. This final day assembly has really been valued over the past few year's especially with the support of our families.
