Dear Parents & Carers

At the end of this busy half term we write to update you on the following important information:

Aerosols and Body Sprays

As previously advised, these items are banned from school. Only roll-on products are allowed. To protect our asthmatic children and staff at Marshland we asked all students not to bring them to school and use them, regardless of where they are on the school premises. They can cause a fatal reaction. A recent spot check found many children carrying items in their bags. Serious sanctions will be put in place for any student flouting this rule.

Medication

As a reminder, we are legally not allowed to keep non-prescribed medicines for students (including paracetamol). Any prescribed medicine that students may have to take during school hours, must be handed in and signed for by the parent or carer at reception. Children are allowed to have one dose of paracetamol with them in their bag for headaches, period pains, aches and pains, etc.

Summer Term

With temperatures set to rise after half term, please ensure your child has a bottle of water in their bag to stay hydrated during the day. In the case of extreme temperatures please ensure your child has a hat/suncream as appropriate. We will update you on blazer arrangements in the case of excessive temperatures.

With more children cycling in, they must wear a helmet, it could save their life.
