Year 7 Update

Further to the letter you received from Mr Jansen at the end of last week, we write to update you on what your child can expect whilst they are in school between Monday 31st October to Friday 4th November.

We are prioritising Year 7 students as we recognise parents will be more concerned regarding child care arrangements and independent learning given the age of these students. It is essential that all Year 7 students are attending school whilst we are closed for some year groups.

Students will still access their normal timetable and lessons, with their allocated teacher, but may have to change classrooms.

As a result, each student will be given a new timetable, specifically for this week only, when they arrive in school on Monday 31st October. Students are expected to arrive ready for an 8.45am start, go straight to the Blue Sports Hall, to be greeted and receive their individual timetables.

There are no other changes in relation to uniform (including PE), catering, toilets, and buses will run as normal. Bus 46 from Wisbech will only be operating one loop each day (rather than two). If your child attends after-school clubs, please ensure they check with individual teachers if they will be taking place during this week.

Year 7 Tutor Evening planned for Thursday 3rd November will be postponed until the following week Thursday 10th November. Appointment bookings open today via our <u>Parent Evening system</u>.

Our priority remains the safety and continuity of our students' education, in what is a very important time for Year 7.
