## **Marshland Christmas Update**

With the holidays fast approaching I wanted to update you on our busy Autumn term and to thank you for your continued support.

Our last day of term is Wednesday 20th December 2023 when the school closes to all students at 12.30pm. Lessons continue as normal up until this time and it is important for students to be in school.

For most students, transport will be here for the earlier finish time with the exception of Bus 60 and those students will travel on Bus 46 to Wisbech. Lynx Bus 1 is a service bus with a standard timetable so is unable to arrive early. If your child usually travels on this, we would kindly ask you to make alternative arrangements for this day. Our staff training day takes place on Wednesday 3rd January and all students return to school on Thursday 4th January 2024.

## **Big Norfolk Holiday Fun Scheme**

The <u>Big Norfolk Holiday Fun (BNHF)</u> activity programme is run in partnership with Norfolk County Council, and provides holiday activities for children and young people aged 4-16 in Norfolk.

Children eligible for means-tested free school meals can claim free spaces on the activities, whilst paid spots are available on most activities for those who don't. The next programme will be taking place during the winter holidays on 21-22 December and 2-3 January.
