GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2026

Students may collect their results from the main hall between 9:00am and 10:30am. Parents and carers are welcome to accompany students into school. Alternatively, your child can receive their results via the Department of Education (DfE) app as previously advised.

Prize Giving Celebration and GCSE certificate collection – Thursday 3rd December 2026

We look forward to welcoming students back on Thursday 3rd December for our GCSE Prize Giving Evening, where we will formally celebrate their achievements and present GCSE certificates and awards.

This is a formal event, and students are expected to wear smart business attire. The event will last approximately one hour and will include light refreshments. We encourage all students and families to attend and kindly ask you to mark this date in your calendar.

If your child is unable to attend the event, certificates can be collected from school on Monday 4th January 2027, between 11:00am and 1:00pm.

Please note that it is important students collect their certificates during one of these windows, as universities, colleges, and employers often request to see them as part of an application. Examination boards only allow us to retain certificates for eight months, after which we are required to destroy them. Replacements are not issued by exam boards, but they may provide a formal confirmation of results – this currently costs around £50 per exam board.

- **Laptop Returns:** If your child has been issued with a school laptop or device, please ensure it is returned to reception by Tuesday 14th July 2026.
- **Uniform Donations:** If you no longer require your child's school uniform, PE kit, or other equipment (in good condition), we welcome donations to support other families. Please hand these in at reception.
- **Art and Creative Design Work Collection:** Students who have produced work in Art, 3D Design, Photography, etc., will be able to collect it at the Prize Giving Evening in December or on Monday 4th January 2027.
