Dear Parents & Carers,

Amber Temperature Warnings

With temperatures forecasted to exceed 30 degrees on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, as part of our measures to safeguard our students, normal uniform is not expected to be worn for the rest of this week.

Instead of normal uniform students can wear respectable PE kit. Government advice recommends light colours, rather than dark.

Please ensure your child has:

- a water bottle.
- a suitable/appropriate hat to protect themselves at break and lunchtimes, and
- sun cream/lotion on exposed skin. Aerosol sun care products **MUST NOT** be brought into school.

This is especially important for students out on trips this week, including the Geography Field Trip to Hunstanton, the Royal Norfolk Show and the French Trip leaving on Friday.

Students will be allowed to drink water during most lessons. In certain rooms (ICT, DT, Science) children will be required to step outside the classroom to drink, due to equipment.

Children must ensure they fill their water bottles up at least 5 minutes before the end of their break and lunchtimes at the designated water machines to ensure they are not late to their lessons. Late arrival to lessons will be sanctioned as normal.

The school sports hall will be open at lunch time to facilitate students escaping the heat. This is in addition to the canopy areas and main hall.

Please note, for the welfare of staff, formal wear will not be required to be worn by school staff on these three days. Staff therefore may be in suitable casual wear at the Year 7 Parents Evening on Thursday.
